

Crackdown against Hoarding and Smuggling of Essential Commodities

Last week, strict action was taken by the interim Interior Minister Sarfaraz Bugti against culprits involved in the smuggling and hoarding of essential commodities. Around 90 middlemen were found to be involved in hoarding activities that caused artificial shortages and increases in prices in the country.

The Market prices of urea for farmers sharply reduced by some Rs 500 to 600 per bag due to the government's crackdown, whereas around 90,000 bags of fertilizers have been confiscated from various parts of Sindh.
